

# Sample Uganda Mission Trip Itinerary

Dates, locations, and details vary by trip. This itinerary represents a typical experience and is intentionally generalized for safety.

## Day 1 – Team Departure

- Team travel to U.S. departure airport
- International flight to Uganda

## Day 2 – International Arrival

- Evening arrival in Uganda
- Airport pickup and group transfer
- Overnight rest at a guesthouse near the airport

## Day 3 – Travel & Orientation

- Morning rest and light meal
- Travel inland to ministry headquarters, including essential stops
- Evening dinner, orientation, and team briefing

- Afternoon return to ministry headquarters
- Evening dinner and team evaluation

## Day 8 – Ministry Wrap-Up & Team Reflection

- Morning devotional and breakfast
- Final ministry engagement or work session
- Afternoon rest and processing time
- Evening campfire reflection, testimony sharing, and prayer

### Days 9–10 – Safari & Cultural Experience

- Travel to national park region
- Guided safari experiences
- Team rest and celebration of the trip's completion

### Day 11 – Return Travel

- Afternoon return toward Entebbe
- Late lunch and final team time
- Evening airport drop-off for international departure
